Mr. William B. Brock was the Equal Employment Opportunity Coordinator recruited by Volkswagen of America, Inc. in July 1977, to ease racial tensions and establish effective change between VW, the black community and government agencies in the late 70's and early 80's.
As the most prominent black executive at Volkswagen of America, Mr. Brock was proficient in his field of expertise. Only hours after he'd joined the \$70 Million dollar class action discrimination lawsuit against the automaker, where he himself had the bulk of the damaging information against the company. It was alleged that Mr. Brock shot himself. However, experts disagree with his death being labeled a suicide. Evidence strongly indicates Mr. Brock was murdered and great efforts are being invested in covering it up. You may already be familiar with the history.
